## Cemetery Fee Schedule

Effective 1 April 2026

### Definition of Parishioner

A parishioner is any person resident within the Parish of Honeybourne at the time of death. A non-parishioner is any person who was not resident within the Parish of Honeybourne at the time of death.

**Note A — Gravedigger fee:** The gravedigger fee is a separate charge and is not set by the Parish Council. All grave digging must be carried out by the Council's appointed grave digger.

**Note B — Weekend and bank holiday burials:** The Council does not accommodate burials on Saturdays, Sundays or bank holidays.
