

Poppies to Paddington



More than 200 poppy wreaths were carried to the capital today as part of Great Western Railway's latest Poppies to Paddington operation. Five 'Poppy' trains – starting from Plymouth, Carmarthen, Taunton, Worcester Shrub Hill and Great

Malvern – made their way to London ahead of the remembrance service at Paddington's iconic war memorial.

This morning at 7:57 am the Chair of the Parish Council, on behalf of the residents of Honeybourne, handed a wreath to the GWR staff on the 'Poppy Train' to be carried to Paddington Station.
